Hello Hubbie Boy,

I thought I would enclose a few
lines with Evelyn's letter. I am
here at Alvin's with her. Lorene and
Evelyn changed jobs last night
Lorene went home and Evelyn and
I come here. I'm trying to help out
a little. They're getting along fine here.
Karen is growing a little each day.
She is really a beautiful little baby.
I think she looks more like Albee
than Alvin her hair is a little
lighter than Davids was and it looks
like her eyes may stay blue.
It's really a little early to tell if her
hair is going to be curly. But I
believe it is. It just wouldn't be
fair if she didn't get curly hair
when her brother is such a curly
top.

I don't know how long I'm going to
stay down here. But I'm in the
hurry to go back to D.C. because I
haven't started on a new job.

Hubbie Darling, we had hoped all
along that you wouldn't have to go
into combat right away. But now
that we know you are in - we shall

try not to worry Hub, rather pray more
ferrently each day that our heavenly
father will guard and protect you
from all harm of body and soul.

Rev. Stuenkel had a fine sermon
yesterday morning. Evie, has told you
she got ~~it~~ from your letter of prayer
and your trust in the Lords protection.
Somehow I knew it was you he was
speaking of. And after church he
said to us that was Hubert I
preached about.

Hubbie, the place you said Martin J.
might be able to tell us about. was
marked out in your letter. - We figure
you are on the French + German border
near Metz. Now we would like to know
which army you are with. Vera thinks
the 7th is she right. We take it you
have been inside Germany.

The letter Lorene, said they got today
written ^{Feb 1st} where you were in a
French home was encouraging. hope
you will often be taken into a home
and get some warm food.

They have been getting lots of letters from
Ferner the past week. He is in Germany
But they don't think in combat. He had
gotten some letters on Feb. 17th. He asked for
your add. and here is his (Serial No. 37748942)
