A week has passed already again since I wrote you - goodness, the time sure slips by in a hurry for me. Hope it goes fast for you too. We sure were glad to hear from you again yesterday. The letter you wrote Mar. 10th, so you see it got here in 10 days that's really good. The V-mail you wrote Mar. 6th we received Saturday Mar. 17th. We sure are glad you are getting some training now. When we hear the news we always wonder if you are in it again and with ~~with~~ which Army you sure have us puzzled on that. I think you have told all except with which Army - so now we are trying to find out with which Army Chap. Drapatin is connected and then we will know. Mildred and Elce got Mrs. Drapatin's address for us so we wrote and ask her - because we couldn't find anyone around here who

knew. The fact that you are in
France so much of the time
leads us to believe you are either
with the 3rd or 7th Vera, said Corp
had also visited Nancy.
I was over to Alvin's last night. They
let me read the ^{letter} you wrote them
on the 27th that sure is a fine letter
In fact all your letters are "super-duper".
Mom & I were over to see Pearl Herman
one day and she got out her letter
you had written her on the boat.
She said I want you to read this
it's the best letter I ever got in my
life. So you see how your letters rate.
Ella sent me the letters that come
to my N. C. address after I come home.
I guess you'll be surprised to hear
that I'm still home but I'm enjoying
myself so much I hate to go back
to the city to work. I have decided
to stay home until after Easter at
least. It is really is getting to be pretty
and springlike - It didn't get as cold
last night as was the prediction.
Louene wants me to help her clean
closets so I guess I better get going.
Oh yes, I want to tell you yet what is
in the box we sent yesterday -
mom made a prune cake and we
decided to see if it wouldn't go thru

as well as a fruit cake
Sure hope it won't get molded or
sour. Please let us know what
condition it is in when you get
it. I put some chocolate and
peanut candy in on top of the cake
After I had it wrapped I thought
maybe that wasn't such a good
Idea the chocolate will probably
be soft and sticky. I hope not.
then we put in the box around
the cake tin 2 pkg. noodle soup
that all you have to do is add water
and heat it. I hope you can make
use of it. We also put in a small can
of deviled ham and potted meat - we
opened a can of potted meat we had left
for lunch yesterday. I didn't it was
very good so if you don't like it hand
it down to the next guy. Ha, ha.
We can't get any oil sardines at least
we haven't found any yet. Last week we
sent you a can of the only kind we could
get. But will keep on trying also will get

chocolate malt I thought you could
