Dear Hub.

Wonder how you are making it by now. We are all fine hope you are to. It has been raining here yesterday and today until noon. so it will be to wet to sew oats for a few days. We started sewing sat afternoon we started sewing on the 56 then went to Puggys and sewed  $2\frac{1}{2}$  acres after 6/30 o'clock. That's is what a big drill will do. <sup>to</sup> <sub>to</sub> I wish you could help.

us we are short a good  
man: Martin and I are  
sewing together.

This morning I took  
Evelyn over to Alvin's  
and also took his wagon  
along it was here. I got  
the disk on it the other  
day. We had it in the shed  
over there.

Yesterday was Sunday  
and some of our cows  
were out so I thought  
I would fix a little  
fence. I put in 4 water  
gaps and when I was  
still working on the  
last one I thought the

water was getting higher  
I looked up the creek  
and I could see it was  
getting muddy so I started  
for the other side by  
the time I got there the  
water was running in  
my boats. Then I went  
to the other place and  
fed the cattle hay by  
the time I started home  
the first gap was out  
already. Pretty dumb don't  
you think, I could of  
just as well slept or  
wrote to you.

I have been writing  
this pretty fast but I

hope you can read it  
It is about ten o'clock  
and I have to go the barn  
yet I think one will come  
fresh. Oh yes did I ever  
tell you I have another  
Reg. bull calf from the old  
cow. So I got 3 young bulls  
and one old one know.

By the way I hope  
this pleases you. We broke  
Jina; yes Jim. He work<sub>2</sub>  
just fine the first day we  
hauled two loads of wood  
and gathered two loads of  
corn at Mattins. He got  
pretty tired by nite. But he  
stayed right in the buggy.

we sold Dairy & thought  
I had written you that  
but Louene said & didn't.

Gag the alfalfa really  
looks good now. Wish  
you could see it, and  
also help put it in the  
barn.

Well I better go to the  
barn and see if I've  
got a black baby yet.
