the day we planted potatoes

we are putting the potatoes  
on the same patch.

Martin bought a two disc  
slow a John Deere. We like  
it pretty well. We are plowing  
over at his place now.

The Boucher's <sup>new</sup> sold were  
Diamonds. ~~live~~ someone  
that works in a defense plant  
bought it I don't know his name.  
He won't get possession until  
October though.

I have the eleven hogs  
about ready for the market.  
I think we will feed them  
a week or two yet.
